

Torrossa Digital Library: spring update

The Torrossa platform provides visibility, distribution support and technology to academic publishers, while simplifying purchasing, licensing and access for institutions.

NEW CONTENT

Some of the most prominent and historical Italian publishers will become available on Torrossa in the next few months, including Adelphi, Baldini e Castoldi, Bollati Boringhieri, Bompiani, Donzelli, Gangemi, Garzanti, Giuffré, Laterza, Marsilio, Ponte alle Grazie, Rosenberg & Sellier and UTET.

Archives and new content will be added to the Digital Library for single purchase thanks to a new agreement between Casalini Libri and several major Italian publishing groups to improve the dissemination of their content in digital format.

A new agreement has been signed with UNE (Unión de Editoriales Universitarias Españolas) for the distribution of print and electronic material. Several publishers have already agreed, including Universitat de València, Cilengua, Universidad de Las Palmas de Gran Canaria, Universidad de Zaragoza, Universidad de Cádiz, Universidad de Cantabria, and Casa de Velázquez university presses. This raises the total of associated presses on the Torrossa platform to approximately one third of UNE's 60 members and we expect to extend our catalogue to include further UNE members in the future.

Shibboleth is among the world's most widely deployed federated identity solutions, connecting users to applications both within and between organisations. It provides Single Sign-On capabilities and allows sites to make informed authorisation decisions for individual access of protected online resources in a privacy-preserving manner.

TORROSSA ONLINE DOCUMENT READER

We have launched a **new integrated tool** providing **easier visualisation of full text content** available in the Torrossa digital library. The Reader is compatible with major internet browsers and does not require additional plug-ins or settings. It has been specifically developed to improve visualisation from tablets and smart phones.

A dedicated portal now gives academic publishers the possibility to reach a wider audience by offering research content to the scientific community in Open Access.
