

# Torrossa Digital Library: spring update

The Torrossa platform provides visibility, distribution support and technology to academic publishers, while simplifying purchasing, licensing and access for institutions.

### LEO S. OLSCHKI TITLES PUBLISHED IN 2017

The Leo S. Olschki publishing house has now released the electronic editions of a further 49 monographs, published during 2017. These titles join essential sources of material for researchers already present on the Torrossa platform, encompassing the publisher's entire catalogue from 2000 to 2017.

## **ARCO LIBROS**

A set of 40 e-books composed of new and archive titles by the renowned Spanish publisher Arco Libros, considered a leader in field of philology, is available on Torrossa. This new set complements the existing collection of e-books from the publisher that now counts 148 titles.

# **ÉCOLE FRANÇAISE DE ROME NEW TITLES**

The expected **2018 increment of 10 new titles** has been added to the École française de Rome collection on Torrossa. The collection currently consists of over 300 e-books as well as 3 journals, and includes most of the publisher's production from 2000.

Franco Angeli offers six months of free access to 19 scholarly journals. All the titles are indexed in major citation databases (Scopus, Web of Science) and include access to over 15 years of backfiles. Download, print and copy/paste are allowed for the contents.
