Collection contents exceed 150,000 e-Journal articles and e-Book texts

Casalini Libri Digital Division is pleased to announce that the digital contents of its platform **Editoria Italiana Online** have exceeded 150,000 texts from over 5,200 monographic works and conference proceedings and 360 current journals. The works, principally in the fields of Humanities and Social Sciences, represent 80 Italian publishing houses.

Editoria Italiana Online, the Italian collection of research texts, has, since 2003, offered to libraries, academic institutions and university consortia worldwide a **unique interface through which to access texts from Italy's principal cultural publishing houses**.

Secure viewing is made possible by the platform's tailor-made **DRM** system, which integrates sophisticated digital rights management with advanced search functionalities. The collaboration of an ever-increasing number of publishers allows for the continuous development of the collection, with **new texts added on a monthly basis**.
