Easier access to Torrossa for library users

We are pleased to announce that Shibboleth is now available on the Torrossa platform, widening the range of access options to the platform for libraries and their users.

Shibboleth is among the world's most widely deployed federated identity solutions, connecting users to applications both within and between organisations. It provides Single Sign-On capabilities and allows sites to make informed authorisation decisions for individual access of protected online resources in a privacy-preserving manner.

When successfully logged with their institution account through Shibboleth, users may use their personal Torrossa credentials to access the workspace functions.
