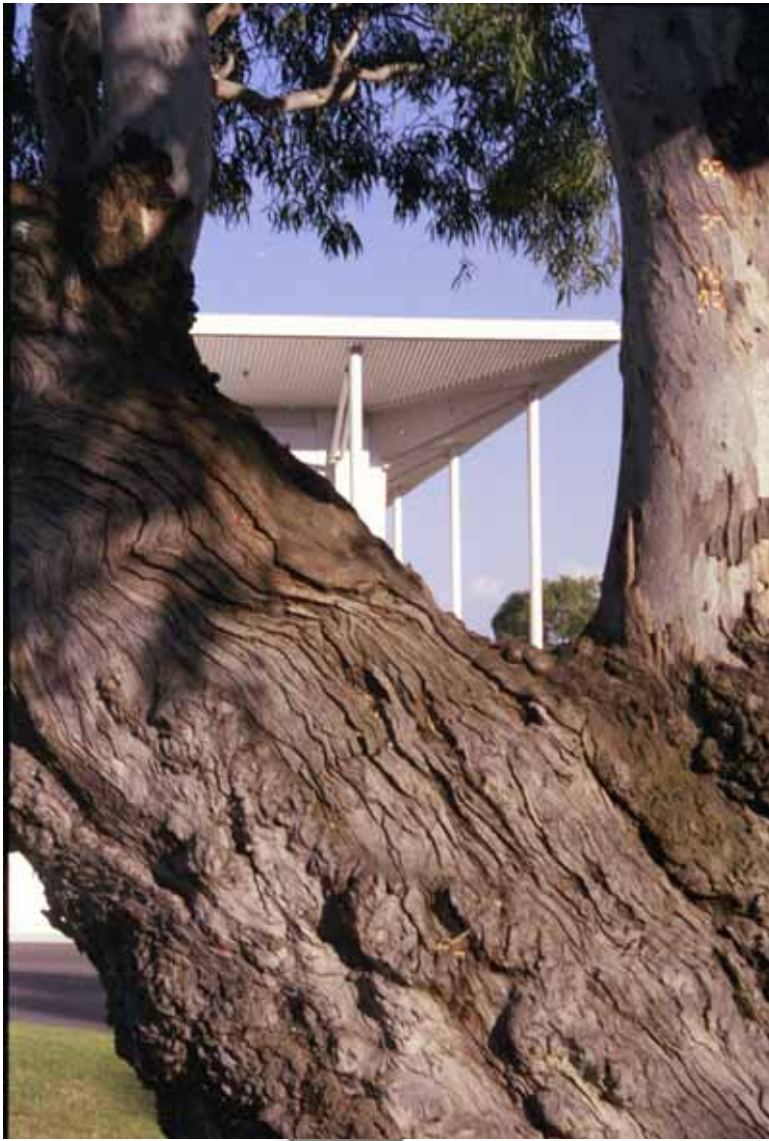

- **Model Licence for collaborative deals**

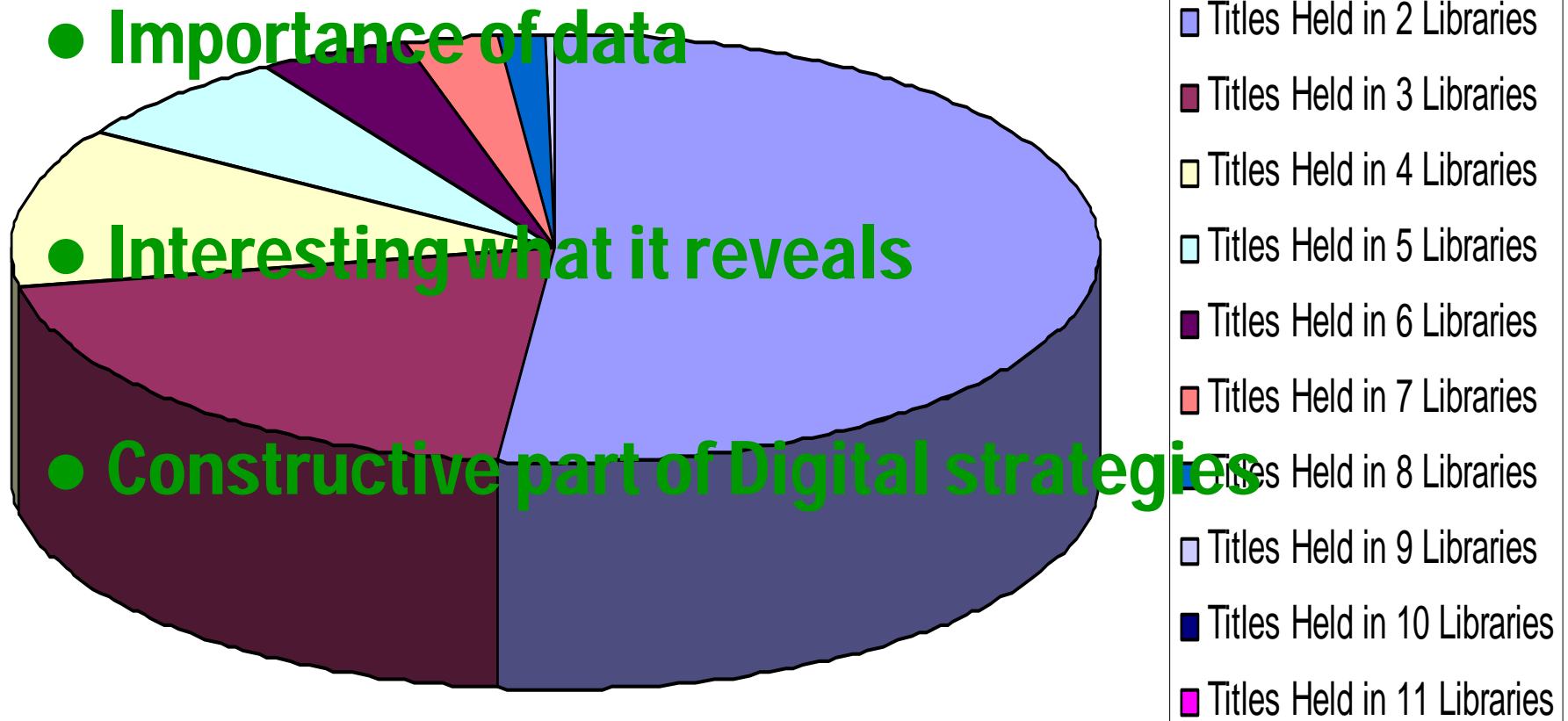


CARM Operations

- **Jointly-owned, consortium-operated**
- **Ownership consigned to joint body**
- **Commitment to future**
- **1 million capacity... to 2.7million**
- **Collects what original owners considered important but now low-use**

Collection Management

- **Do all low use items need to be retained?**
 - Shared information on titles retained
 - Shared increases overall collection reduction
 - Shared increases, NOT reduces collections 'owned'
 - Relationship to Local publishing and collecting
- **Develop infrastructure to low-use collections**
 - Reduce collection/retention costs, increase material access range

Role in a Digital Environment

- Legacy collections critically important
- Total information solution
- Potential changes in distribution and archiving
- Digital delivery is the real solution

Establishment of Conceptual Information models

- **Change mentality**
- **Focus staff on information retrieval and delivery**
- **Linking repositories nationally and internationally**
- **Not just archival but vital low use source**
